Notice of Minimum Wage Increase to \$12.00 per hour Effective January 1, 2019

Effective January 1, 2019, the California minimum wage will increase from \$11.00 per hour to \$12.00 per hour, and the California State University will change the salary range for the Hourly Classification Codes below:

If you have employees currently appointed at less than these new minimums, their pay rate will be automatically updated to the minimum of \$12.00 per hour effective January 1, 2019.

Please note, the full-time salary rate for non-hourly classifications that are below the new minimum will increase to \$2080.00 per month effective January 1, 2019.
