CalHR offers a supplemental retirement benefit program through Savings Plus. Savings Plus is a voluntary program that complements your pension to help you achieve your desired lifestyle in retirement. We offer a 401(k) Plan and a 457(b) Plan with both pre-tax and Roth (after-tax) contribution options.

Contributions are pre-tax; the pension benefit is taxable upon receipt.	Pre-tax contributions and earnings are taxable upon distribution; Roth (after-tax) contributions and earnings may be tax free upon distribution.
A fixed, lifetime benefit — the monthly distribution amount depends on your retirement formula and years of service.	This supplemental benefit allows you to have control over your contributions, investments and distributions.
